




Components measured by WEAI







Increased Agricultural Productivity at the Household level



LEGEND

Green arrows (\uparrow) denote strong evidence of direct associations with agricultural productivity. Gray arrows (\uparrow) denote indirect associations with less conclusive evidence.

*The Women's Empowerment in Agriculture Index (WEAI) measures the following domains in the diagram: Decision-making over 7production, Access to and control over productive resources, Control over income, Time use, and Leadership and social capital.








WEAI Review

WEAI scores range from zero to one; higher values = greater empowerment



WEAI Review – 5 Domains

We have a WEAI. Now what?

- The Gender Integration Framework (GIF)
 - Focuses on the 7 dimensions/domains of women's empowerment in agriculture
 - Is a conversation guide to examine & prioritize
 - the current status of different components of empowerment,
 - reasons for barriers or strengths,
 - what activities exist or are needed in programming,
 - how to measure progress
- "Plug" the WEAI into the GIF
